### *Benefits of being on the HAPT Board:*

Besides knowing that you are doing your part in supporting a very worthwhile organization that you have benefited from in the past, did you know that both your APT and your HAPT dues for the year are waived? On top of that, you get to attend our big conference in February for free (as well as the two mini-conferences in May and October)!! For a one year term, this translates into a \$75 free membership, and a \$190 fee waiver to attend the conference.

For the President-elect position, we're talking about a savings of \$225 on membership over the three years on the board, and approximately \$500 - \$600 saved in conference fees. In addition to these benefits, the president is entitled to a trip to the national APT conference, which is largely subsidized by HAPT.
